2/3 yard EACH of six different purple prints (or your own color choice)

2/3 yard EACH of six different green prints (or your own color choice)

*1/2 yard of black and white print for large blocks centers (or your own color choice)

*1/4 yard of black and white print for small blocks centers (or your own color choice)

*Fabric for the block centers can be from the same fabric if desired.

2/3 yard of fabric for binding

5 1/4 yards of fabric for backing

CUTTING FOR BLOCKS: Variety of purple prints: 24 strips 4" x 20" & 12 strips 5 1/2" x 20" & 12 strips 6 1/2" x 20"Variety of green prints: 24 strips 4" x 20" & 12 strips 5 1/2" x 20" & 12 strips 6 1/2" x 20"From the fabric for the small block centers: 24 squares 3" x 3"From the fabric for the large block centers: 24 squares 4" x 4"
