

Funky Curvy Rail

Finished Size: 63" x 80"

Finished Block Size: 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

This is a "no fail" design! New stack, shuffle, slice and sew methods for cutting and sewing make this a fun and original quilt to make. Gentle curves that aren't cranky, (no pinning), no seams to match make this quilt a blast to make! Easy to make smaller or larger.

FABRIC TIP:

Choose a range of green small-scale prints to combine with a range of black and white small scale prints darks, or choose a color combination of your own.

SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: *Stack New Deck!* By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Several pieces of blank paper

Safety pin

12 1/2" x 12-1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall

FABRIC:

3/8 yd EACH of 8 DIFFERENT green prints for blocks (for a total of 8)

3/8 yd EACH of 8 DIFFERENT black-and-white prints for blocks (for a total of 8)

1 3/8 yd of green for outer border

1/2 yd black for inner border

1/8 yd of black for ladybug bodies (if desired)

1 square, 4" x 4" each for ladybug wings (if desired)

4 7/8 yds for backing

3/8 yd for binding

PLEASE PRECUT EACH OF THE 8 GREEN PRINTS FOR THE BLOCKS INTO A TOTAL OF 24 RECTANGLES 10 1/2" X 13" EACH

PRECUT EACH OF THE 8 BLACK & WHITE PRINTS FOR THE BLOCKS INTO A TOTAL OF 24 RECTANGLES 10 1/2" X 13" EACH
