Finished Block Size: 13" x 14"

This is a quilt you'll make again and again AND each one will always have it's own look with different block arrangements and layouts from the next.

SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: Color Shuffle! By Karla Alexander

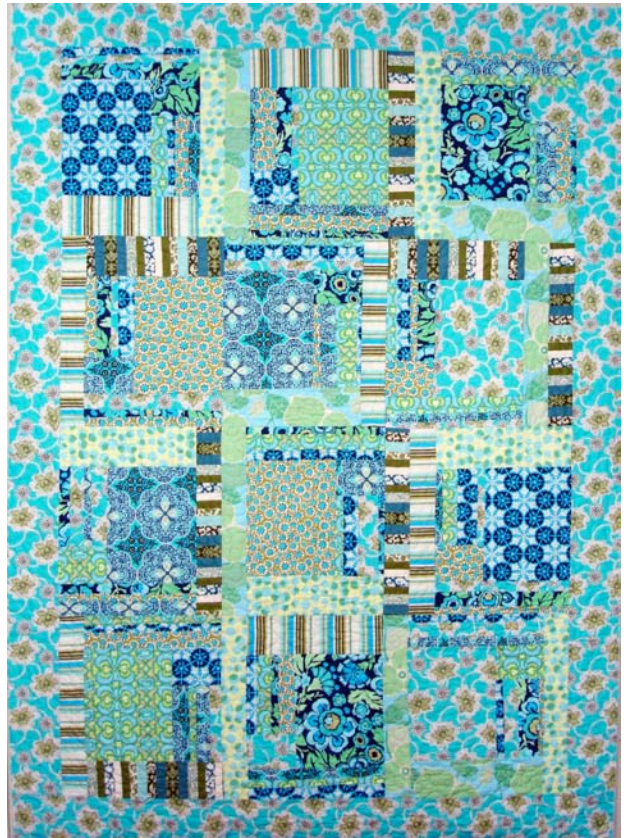
Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Safety pin

12 1/2" x 12-1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall



FABRIC:

1 2/3 yards of turquoise medium to large scale for blocks and border

1/2 yard EACH of 5 different blue and turquoise prints in a variety of small, medium and large scale for blocks

3/8 yard EACH of 4 different blue and turquoise prints for sashing (can be the same as block fabric)

5/8 fabric for binding

5 1/4 yards for backing

PLEASE PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS, REFER TO THE BOOK FOR INSTRUCTIONS.
