

In Full Bloom

Finished Size: 52" x 73"

Finished Block Size: 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"

Fabric Tip:

This quilt with its watercolor appearance requires floral fabrics with an uneven distribution of swirling flower, vines and branch motifs. Fabrics with a variety of multicolored medium to large-scale floral motifs work best for this style of quilt.

You will need a variety of 30 fabrics in a range of values; choose 5 different values each of a light (with lots of light background), a medium-light, a medium, a medium dark and a dark.

It's always nice when you can use fabric from your stash, so check the fabric requirements before you head for the fabric store.

SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: *Stack the Deck!* By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Several pieces of blank paper

Safety pin

12 1/2" x 12 1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall

FABRIC: (PLEASE PRECUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS)

3/8 yard *EACH* of 6 different light floral prints OR 6 different 11" x 11" light floral squares for blocks

3/8 yard *EACH* of 6 different medium light floral prints OR two sets of 6 different 11" x 11" medium light floral squares (total 12) for blocks

3/8 yard *EACH* of 6 different medium floral prints OR two sets of 6 different 11" x 11" medium light floral squares (total 12) for blocks

3/8 yard *EACH* of 6 different medium dark floral prints OR three sets of 6 different 11" x 11" medium dark floral squares (total 18) for blocks

3/8 yard *EACH* of 6 different dark floral prints OR four sets of 6 different 11" x 11" dark floral squares (total 24) for blocks

1 1/8 yards for setting triangles

5/8 yard for binding

3 1/2 yard for backing
