

# Run for Color

Finished Size: 63 1/4" x 82 3/4"

Block Size: 7 3/4" x 7 3/4"

To achieve the awesome color effect for this quilt I used many different prints. I enjoy working from my stash, pulling in prints as I go. This is all a lot of fun – that is until I write the pattern and attempt to explain fabric requirements! With that in mind, the list below definitely has excess of certain colors (mainly gold). So, you can choose to cut individual rectangles for each color way from your stash or purchase the number of fat quarters listed in Materials below.

## SUPPLIES:

Suggested Pattern: Run For Color

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

9 1/2" x 9 1/2" square ruler – or larger

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall

## Materials

- 8 different fat quarters in a mix of dark blue and purple  
OR a variety of 24 rectangles, 9" x 13"
- 6 different fat quarters in a mix of turquoise and blue  
OR a variety of 18 rectangles, 9" x 13"
- 6 different fat quarters in a mix of lime green  
OR a variety of 18 rectangles, 9" x 13"
- 6 different fat quarters in a mix of gold and yellow  
OR a variety of 18 rectangles, 9" x 13"
- 1/3 yard each of 3 different black and white prints
- 1/3 yard each of 3 different white and black prints
- 1/3 yard black and white print for inner border
- 1 1/3 yards purple for outer border
- 5/8 yard fabric for binding
- 5 yards fabric for backing
- 72" x 91" piece of batting
- Suggested Ruler: **Curved Slotted Ruler, CGRKA4 by Creative Grids**

PLEASE PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS, REFER TO THE PATTERN FOR INSTRUCTIONS.
