## DESCRIPTION:

A mix of subtle-design small to medium scale batiks creates a flowing patchwork of color in this quilt. Each block in this awesome quilt is different from the next using gentle free-form curves as desired. If you're uncomfortable with curves, straight line cuts will work as well

## FABRIC TIPS:

Select subtle batiks with small to medium scale patterns to make sure the fabric doesn't overwhelm the block design. Chose your own palette of colors in lights and mediums.

## SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: Color Shuffle! By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Several pieces of blank paper

12 1/2" x 12-1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall



## FABRIC:

1 yard EACH of 3 different light soft beige for blocks and setting triangles

2/3 yard EACH of 2 additional different soft beige for blocks

1 yard EACH of 3 different medium to dark brown batiks for blocks and setting triangles

2/3 yard EACH of 2 additional different medium to dark brown batiks for blocks

2/3 yard of binding fabric

5 1/2 yard of backing fabric

PLEASE REFER TO BOOK AND PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS

YOU WILL NEED 30 EACH OF LIGHT BATIKS CUT INTO RECTANGLES 10 1/2" x 12 1/2"

YOU WILL NEED 30 EACH OF DARK BATIKS CUT INTO RECTANGLES 10 1/2" x 12 1/2"
