

Somersault

Finished Size: 52" x 68"

Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"

Learn this easy method of making wavy blocks all with different sized squares that somersault down the wiggly path. You can change it up as you go by adding more squares IF you want, or mix up the layout. It's up to you and the techniques are so much fun - you'll use them over and over again! Borders optional.

SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: Color Shuffle By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

12 1/2" x 12-1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall



FABRIC:

3/8 yard EACH of 9 different light prints in the turquoise blue and purple range

3/8 yard EACH of 9 different dark prints in the turquoise blue and purple range

5/8 yard of fabric for binding

3 3/8 yards of backing fabric

PLEASE PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS

CUTTING FOR BLOCKS:

Cut a variety of 36 squares, 8" x 8" from the light color range

Cut a variety of 36 squares, 8" x 8" from the dark color range
